# **Scorpion Horse Locust**

Large monstrosity, chaotic evil

**Challenge** 12 (8,400 XP)

**Terrifying Buzz.** When a creature starts its turn within 30 feet of the Scorpion Horse Locust, it must succeed on a DC 16 Wisdom saving throw or be frightened until the start of its next turn. A creature can repeat the saving throw at the end of each of its turns, ending the frightened condition on a success.

**Pincer Attack.** Melee Weapon Attack: +9 to hit, reach 10 ft., one target. Hit: 20 (3d8 + 7) piercing damage plus 9 (2d8) poison damage. The target must succeed on a DC 18 Constitution saving throw or be paralyzed for 1 minute. The target can repeat the saving throw at the end of each of its turns, ending the paralysis on a success.

**Leap.** The Scorpion Horse Locust can leap up to 30 feet in a straight line and does not provoke opportunity attacks when it does so.

**Swarm Tactics.** The Scorpion Horse Locust has advantage on an attack roll against a creature if at least one of the Scorpion Horse Locust's allies is within 5 feet of the creature and the ally isn't incapacitated.

**Legendary Resistance (3/Day).** If the Scorpion Horse Locust fails a saving throw, it can choose to succeed instead.

## **Actions**

**Multiattack.** The Scorpion Horse Locust makes three pincer attacks.

**Poisonous Tail.** Melee Weapon Attack: +9 to hit, reach 10 ft., one target. Hit: 16 (3d6 + 5) piercing damage plus 7 (2d6) poison damage. The target must succeed on a DC 18 Constitution saving throw or take 21 (6d6) poison damage at the start of its next turn. On a successful save, the poison damage is halved.

## **Legendary Actions**

The Scorpion Horse Locust can take 3 legendary actions, choosing from the options below. Only one legendary action can be used at a time and only at the end of another creature's turn. The Scorpion Horse Locust regains spent legendary actions at the start of its turn.

Pincer Attack. The Scorpion Horse Locust makes one pincer attack.

Terrifying Buzz (Costs 2 Actions). The Scorpion Horse Locust uses its Terrifying Buzz.

**Leap (Costs 3 Actions).** The Scorpion Horse Locust uses its Leap ability.
